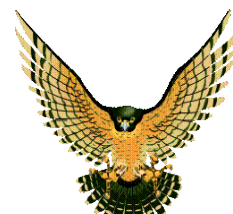

SPANISH 1A

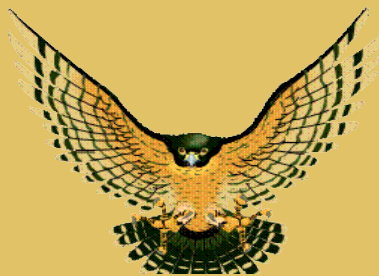

MATH 8/7

The Section Seven test is scheduled for Friday, February 24th. Section Six test corrections are due by Tuesday, February 21st. Students must show steps to get full corrections credit. This week, students will learn about solving implied ratio problems, multiplying and dividing negative and positive numbers, and classifying quadrilaterals.

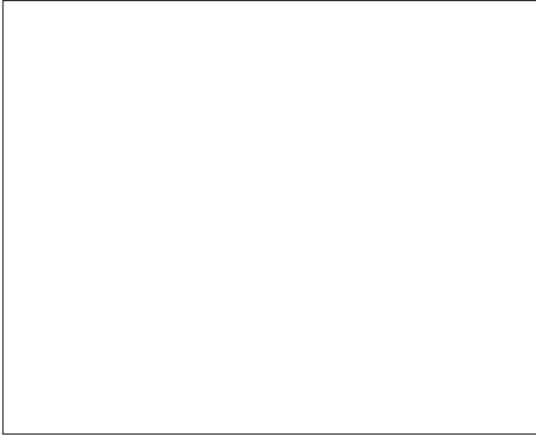
PRE-ALGEBRA

The Section Seven test is scheduled for Friday, March 3rd. Section Six test corrections are due by Wednesday, February 22nd. Students must show steps to get full corrections credit. This week, students will learn about direct variation and how scale factor is related to area and volume. We will also discuss using tree diagrams, tables, and the fundamental counting principle to solve probability problems.

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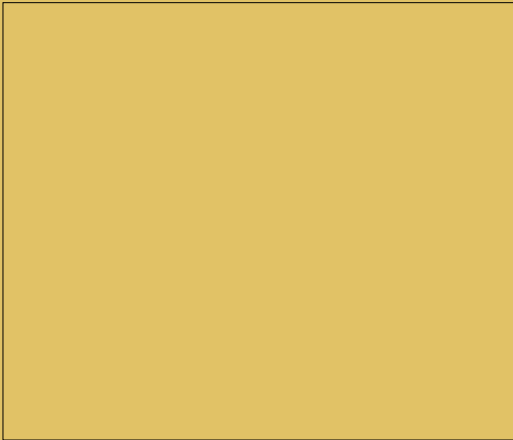
ALGEBRA I
