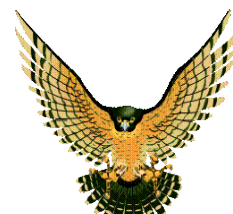

SIXTH GRADE

LANGUAGE ARTS

In sixth grade, the students will continue reading *The Prince and the Pauper*. We will begin writing research papers. They are tentatively due April 12. The spelling quiz will be over words selected from the text.

SOCIAL STUDIES

This week we will continue our study of Latin American Revolutions. This week we will be looking at Simon Bolivar and Mexico's Struggles with Independence. The students have a writing project that is due on April 7. The students can expect homework on Wednesday and Thursday. The Latin America Revolutions test will be next week Monday.

SCIENCE

SPANISH 1A

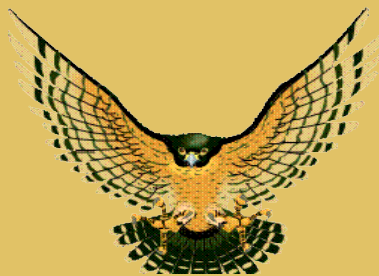

LANGUAGE ARTS
