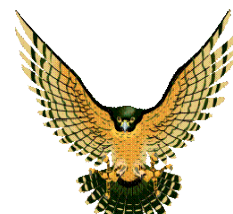

SIXTH GRADE

LANGUAGE ARTS

SPANISH 1A

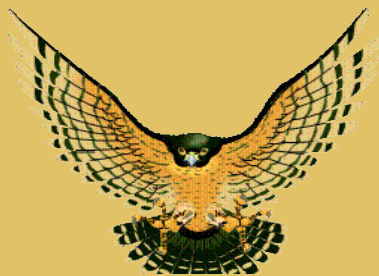

MATH 8/7

Section Seven test corrections are due by Tuesday, March 7th. Students must show steps to get full corrections credit. The next test is tentatively scheduled for Friday, March 24th. This week, students will learn about estimating area and using proportions to solve percent problems. Students will also work on their mathematical symbols projects and have a guest speaker. Due to PAWS testing, students will only have homework on Thursday.

PRE-ALGEBRA

Section Seven test corrections are due by Tuesday, March 21st. Students must show steps to get full corrections credit. This week, students will learn about simplifying square roots and finding the *n*th term in a sequence. They will also work on their mathematician presentations. Due to PAWS testing, students will not have homework Monday or Tuesday.

LANGUAGE ARTS

SPANISH 1B

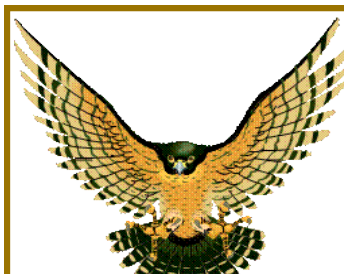
