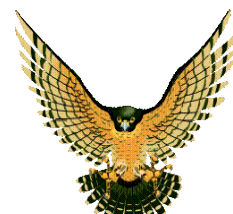

## SPANISH 1A

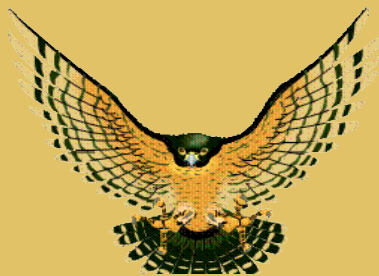

### SPANISH 1B

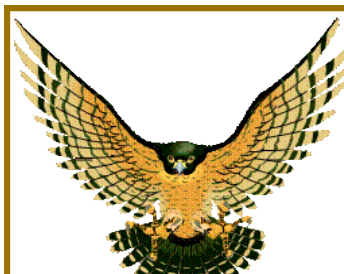
